## JUDGES LIST CRITERIA

### UPDATED 2016

#### A1 BREED SPECIALIST

Open to persons who have previously awarded CCs in the breed, fulfill the K.C. requirements and have the support of the Scottish Collie Club.

#### A1 NON SPECIALIST

Open to persons who have previously awarded CCs in the breed, fulfill the K.C. requirements and have the support of the Scottish Collie Club.

#### A2 BREED SPECIALIST / NON SPECIALIST

For persons who fulfill all the requirements of the A3 list and who have been assessed in accordance with the K.C. guidelines for the inclusion on an A2 list and have the support of the Scottish Collie Club.

#### A3 BREED SPECIALIST

1. Minimum of 10 years experience in the breed and have the support of the Scottish Collie Club.
2. To have judged at Two Breed Club Shows.
3. To have judged a minimum of 100 classes, including the two breed open shows.
4. To have judged a minimum of **200 dogs**
5. To have bred a minimum of 3 dogs who have obtained entry to the K.C. Stud Book.
6. To have stewarding experience over 5 years and 12 shows at both Championship and Open Shows level. Certificates of experience must be submitted with application.
7. Have attended and passed all relevant seminars required by K.C. in e.g.--
  - Rules and Regulations
  - Confirmation and Movement
  - Hands on Final Assessment

## Stewarding and Ring Management.

### A3 NON BREED SPECIALIST

1. Minimum of 10 years experience in any one breed ( to include 5 years in this breed ) and have the support of the Scottish Collie Club
2. To have judged the breed at 20 shows.
3. To have judged a minimum of 150 classes in the breed.
4. To have judged 400 dogs in the breed.
5. To have awarded CCs in at least one breed.
6. To have attended at least one breed seminar and past the assessment as applicable.
7. To have Stewarding Experience over 5 years and 12 shows at both Championship and Open Show level. Certificates of experience must be submitted with application.
8. To have bred a minimum of 3 dogs who have obtained entry to the K.C. Stud Book.
9. Have attended and passed all relevant seminars by K.C. in e.g.-
  - Rules and Regulations
  - Conformation and Movement.
  - Hands on Final Assessment
  - Stewarding and Ring Management.

### B LIST BREED SPECIALISTS

Open to individuals the club will support at breed open shows level.

1. Minimum of 5 years experience of breeding / exhibiting in the breed.
2. Have judged a minimum of 15 classes.
3. Have judged a minimum of **60 dogs**.
4. Must have attended a breed specific and have attended and passed all relevant KC seminars e.g. conformation and movement, Requirements of a Dog Show Judge.
5. A minimum of 3 years and 4 shows stewarding experience at open shows.
6. Fulfill the K.C. requirements of an Open Show Judge.
7. Have the support of the Scottish Collie Club.

### B LIST NON SPECIALIST

Open to non specialist whom the club would support at Open Show level.

1. Have Judged 40 classes in the breed.
2. Have judged a minimum of **70 dogs** in the breed
3. . Have the same experience as specialists with regard to stewarding, breeding, exhibiting, not necessarily within the breed.
4. Must have attended a breed specific seminar and have attended and passed all relevant KC seminars e.g. conformation and movement and Requirements of a dog show Judge

## C LIST

Open to aspiring judges who do not fall into the above categories but the club are willing to support

Would be desirable to have attended a breed specific seminar
